WATER UPDATE

Thank you to those who were able to attend the April Townhall. I appreciated the opportunity to present information and discuss your concerns regarding our business. We will try to make this an annual meeting.

With the season about to kick off we thought an update on the water situation is in order.

With the lower temperatures and recent precipitation locally and in the mountains, we are feeling cautiously optimistic that we will be supporting a routine water season in 2024. We are currently trending in the right direction, and do not foresee any immediate need to put restrictions in place. However, it is important to point out this could change.

We have listened to your request from the Townhall meeting, and our website (wid.net) has been updated to provide you with current, helpful information which is updated weekly. You will find an update from our Water Operations team on our reservoir elevations, a link to Snowpack Charts and a link to view river flows in the Alberta River Basin App. We will continue to provide communications throughout the water season via our website and email updates.

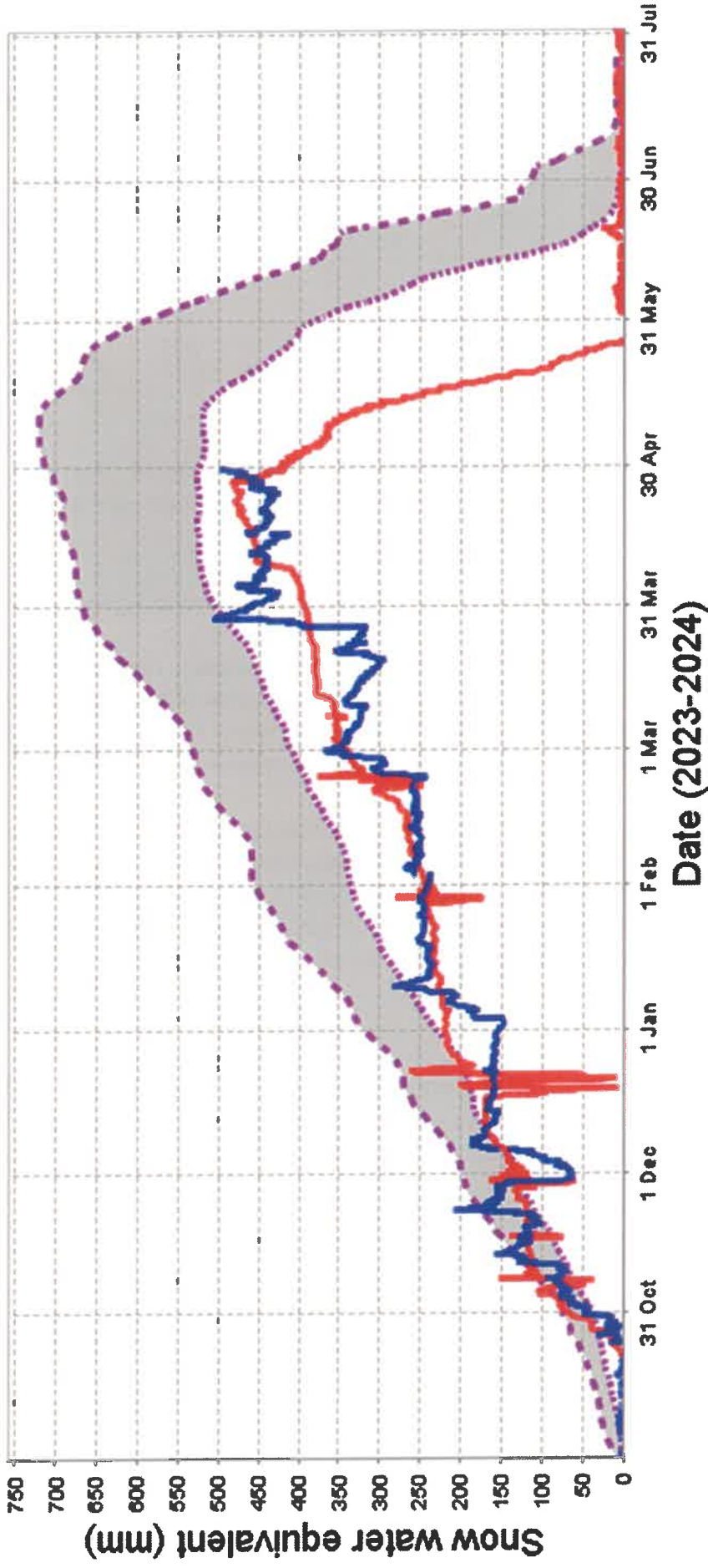

for station 05BB803**

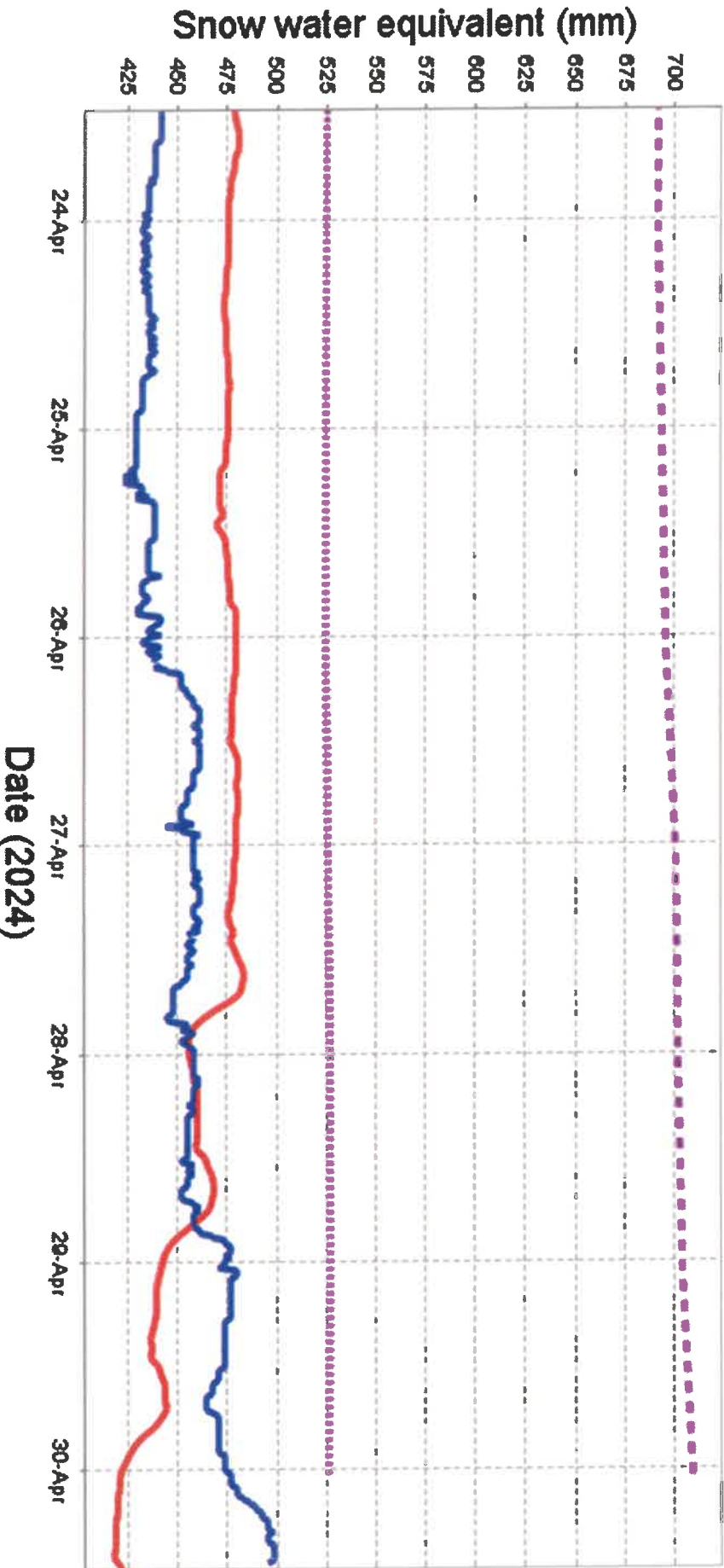
